

2021 Hurst appeared in 40 games for the Lions, starting in 31 games. She picked up 19 hits, three triples while scoring 13 runs with 15 RBIs and 10 stolen bases. Sidnie was named onto the MIAA Academic Honor Roll. In the MIAA, with strong contributions from Hurst, the Lions ranked first in double plays turned, stolen bases per game, stolen bases, triples and triples per game, second in double plays turned per game, hit-by-pitches and sacrifice bunts.

2020 Hurst didn't see any action during the short pandemic season. Sidnie was named onto the MIAA Academic Honor Roll.

2019 Hurst appeared in 28 games and started in 21 games for the Lions in the outfield. She was one of six players to bat over .300 while knocking in eight runs and registering a .441 slugging and a .372 on-base percentage. Sidnie had 21 hits, four doubles, one triple, one home run with 5 stolen bases. On defense, Hurst recorded a 1.000 fielding percentage off of 18 putouts and three assists without an error. Her defensive performance was part of a squad with a fielding percentage of .966 for second overall in the MIAA, with the least amount of errors committed. Sidnie was named onto the MIAA Academic Honor roll with a 3.30 GPA.

Prior to Southern, Hurst was a four-year Letterman at Carl Albert High School. She earned All-Conference First Team honors as a freshman outfielder before taking First Team at shortstop in both, her sophomore and junior years. As a senior, Sidnie attained 5a All-District First Team Honors as an outfielder. She helped launch the Titans toward a 5a Regional Championship in all four years, which eventually lead to a 5a State Championship in 2017. In the offseason, Hurst competed in the pool by swimming in the 50 free, 100 free, 200 relay, and 400 relay for the swim team as a two-year letter winner.
